

HOW MUCH DOES THE S5 SENTINEL SUSPENSION BASE WEIGH?

~ 27lbs (12.2kg)

HOW MUCH DOES THE COMMANDER SEAT WEIGH?

~ 30lbs (13.5kg)

HOW HIGH IS THE S5 SENTINEL SUSPENSION BASE?

8.5" (21.5cm)

WHAT IS THE TRAVEL OF THE S5 SENTINEL?

It offers 4" (10cm) of vertical travel.

DOES THE S5 SENTINEL MOVE FORWARD AT ALL?

Yes. When fully compressed, the module causes the seat to travel forward 1.5" (3.8cm).

CAN THE S5 SENTINEL BE MOUNTED ON A PEDESTAL?

Yes, the S5 Sentinel can be mounted on a pedestal, but only if it is very stout and wide, with a rectangle shaped top plate that is strong enough to support the S5 Sentinel (27lbs), the seat (20-30lbs), and the occupant, plus the additional vertical and horizontal stress from the wave impacts. It's much better to mount it to a riser box.

ARE BLACK AND WHITE THE ONLY COLORS AVAILABLE FOR THE COMMANDER SEAT?

Yes, for standard order seats, but any colours from the below link's "Advantage Marine Vinyls" or "Softside Collection" can be special ordered for no extra cost. The lead time will be about 8 weeks.

CAN I GET A CUP HOLDER WITH THE COMMANDER SEAT?

Yes, the part number for the cup holder is: SW-01688, it comes with an aluminum holder.

DOES THE WHITE SEAT COME WITH WHITE ARMRESTS?

Yes, it does come standard with white armrests.

WHAT IS THE LOAD CAPACITY OF THE S5 SENTINEL SUSPENSION BASE?

The maximum occupant weight for the S5 Sentinel module is 250lbs [113kgs] on a vessel that sees maximum deck accelerations of 3g's. For calmer waters and deck accelerations of less than 2g's, a 300lb [136kg] occupant is acceptable.

SOMEONE IS ASKING ABOUT THE S5 JOCKEY SEAT - WHAT DO I TELL THEM, AND HOW DO I PURCHASE THESE?

Jockey Seats are available through SHOCKWAVE as a special order. They have a longer lead time than the regular S5 Sentinel Base. Call SHOCKWAVE for information.

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WHAT TYPE OF MATERIAL IS THE S5 SENTINEL MADE OF?

Marine grade cast aluminum with 316 stainless steel hardware.

DOES THE SWIVEL/SLIDE FOR THE S5 SENTINEL ADD MUCH PLAY OR MOVEMENT TO THE SEAT?

It has very little lateral play. Likely less play than any other swivel or slide you will find on the market.

HOW MANY POSITIONS DOES THE SWIVEL HAVE?

The Swivel turns 360 degrees, and has 16 positions it can lock into.

HOW MUCH TRAVEL DOES THE SLIDE PROVIDE?

The Slide offers 5" (13cm) of fore/aft travel.

HOW HIGH IS THE SWIVEL/SLIDE AND SLIDE?

The Swivel slide adds 2" (5cm) of height and the slide adds 1.2" (3cm).

CAN I USE THE S5 SENTINEL WITH A SHOCKWAVE ACCESSORY, PAIRED WITH A NON-SHOCKWAVE SEAT?

Should you decide to add a SHOCKWAVE Swivel, Slide or Swivel/Slide accessory, you might want to go with our seat as well. Our seats were designed to work with our accessories. Therefore, if you want to use our accessory with a non-SHOCKWAVE seat, you may need to add an adapter plate that enables them to bolt the seat of your choice to our slide/swivel accessory. We sell a 5x12" adaptor plate. Call for details.

WHAT SHOULD THAT SEAT SAG BE?

If PSI is set correctly, the sag should be at about 20-25%. Set at 'Soft' setting to start. 3/4" compression when seated. Allow for 20% sag. Sag can be set by measuring 0.5" from the top of shockbody.

IS IT NECESSARY TO SELL A SHOCK PUMP WITH THE S5 SENTINEL?

Yes, every boat should have one pump onboard, regardless of how many SHOCKWAVE S5 Sentinels are installed. Your S5 Sentinel customers will need one pump for their boat. We recommend you stock a few of them, or order them with the S5 Sentinel.

The boat owner will need the pump to adjust the pressure at set-up. Also, the pump is needed if an occupant much heavier or lighter than the primary occupant (more than a 50lbs difference) is using the S5 Sentinel. Moreover, the pressure should be checked every year and the S5 Sentinel may need to be adjusted slightly.

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
