Build a Bench Seat with Suspension!

Customers always ask how to use our suspension for a bench seat. Now we have drawings to demonstrate this concept. Both with and without a back, we can provide drawings to help you fit these into your boat design.


Shockwave Seats has designed a bench seat concept with dimensional drawings and material suggestions that can be used by boat builders and boat owners, to incorporate suspension capabilities into their bench seating.


Whether at the helm, nav, or a row across the stern, with or without a back, as many as you like, you can add suspension to any bench seating, as long as your base will accommodate the 8.5" in vertical height that is needed between the seat cushion and the base.



Bench seating with suspension simply needs to have separate seat cushions – we recommend 22.5" - 24" [57I-609 mm] – for each suspension base, and they need to be pressurized individually. The seat can be wider or deeper, these drawings show our suggestion, but the fit can be customized to the space available for the bench.
